Behold, all those who were incensed against you shall be ashamed and disgraced; They shall be as nothing, and those who strive with you shall perish. You shall seek them and not find them—those who contended with you. Those who war against you shall be as nothing, as a nonexistent thing. For I, the Lord your God, will hold your right hand, saying to you, 'Fear not, I will help you.' Isaiah 41:10-13 NKJV

Like a muddied fountain and a polluted spring is a righteous man who yields, falls down, and compromises his integrity before the wicked. Proverbs 25:26 AMPC

Give us help from trouble: for vain is the help of man. Through God we shall do valiantly: for He it is that shall tread down our enemies. Psalm 60:11-12

I was dumb with silence, I held my peace, even from good; and my sorrow was stirred. Psalm 39:2

But the Lord is with me as a Mighty Terrible One: therefore my persecutors shall stumble, and they shall not prevail: they shall be greatly ashamed; for they shall not prosper: their everlasting confusion shall never be forgotten. Jeremiah 20:11

- The eternal God is your refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms. He will drive out your enemies before you, saying, 'Destroy them!' NIV
- The eternal God is thy refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms: and he shall thrust out the enemy from before thee; and shall say, destroy them. KJV

Though I walk in the midst of trouble, You will revive me; You will stretch out Your hand against the wrath of my enemies, and Your right hand will save me. Psalm 138:7 NKJV

- 1 Why are the nations so angry? Why do they waste their time with futile plans?

- 4 But the One who rules in heaven laughs. The Lord scoffs at them.

Keep me safe from the traps set by evildoers, from the snares they have laid for me. Let the wicked fall into their own nets, while I pass by in safety. Psalm 141:9-10 NIV

For they speak not peace: but they devise deceitful matters against them that are quiet in the land.

The Lord your God hath given you rest, and hath given you this land. Joshua 1:13

I will both lie down in peace, and sleep; for You alone, O Lord, make me dwell in safety.
Psalm 4:8 NKJV

Attend unto my cry; for I am brought very low: deliver me from my persecutors; for they are stronger than I. Psalm 142:6

You protect the poor; You protect the helpless when they are in danger. You are like a shelter from storms, like shade that protects them from the heat. The cruel people attack like a rainstorm beating against the wall, like the heat in the desert. But You, God, stop their violent attack. As a cloud cools a hot day, You silence the songs of those who have no mercy. Isaiah 25:4-5 NCV

And you, son of man, do not be afraid of them or their words. Do not be afraid, though briars and thorns are all around you and you live among scorpions. Do not be afraid of what they say or be terrified by them, though they are a rebellious people. Ezekiel 2:6 NIV

He (God) kept them safe so they were not afraid; but the sea covered their enemies.
Psalm 78:53 NLT

Behold, He who keeps Israel will neither slumber nor sleep. Psalm 121:4 AMPC

Because Thou hast been my help, therefore in the shadow of Thy wings will I rejoice. Psalm 63:7

I will call on the Lord, who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from mine enemies.
2 Samuel 22:4

Surely the Lord has done great things! Don't be afraid, O land. Be glad now and rejoice,
for the Lord has done great things. Joel 2:21 NLT

As with a sword in my bones, mine enemies reproach me; while they say daily unto me,
Where is thy God? Psalm 42:10

Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the Lord your God goes
with you; He will never leave you nor forsake you. The Lord Himself goes before you and will be with
you; He will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged.
Deuteronomy 31:6 & 8 NIV

Thus saith the Lord, be not afraid of the words that thou hast heard, wherewith the servants of the king
of Assyria have blasphemed Me. Isaiah 37:6

Be strong and courageous, be not afraid nor dismayed for all the multitude that is with him: for there
be more with us than with him: With him is an arm of flesh; but with us is the Lord our God to help us,
and to fight our battles. 2 Chronicles 32:7-8

Fear not, be not dismayed; for the Lord God, even my God, is with you. He will not fail you or
forsake you 1 Chronicles 28:20 RSV

Thus saith the Lord unto you, be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude;
for the battle is not yours, but God's. 2 Chronicles 20:15

Let those be put to shame who persecute me, but let me not be put to shame; let them be
dismayed, but let me not be dismayed. Bring on them the day of evil, and destroy them with
double destruction. Jeremiah 17:18 AMPC

In God is my salvation and my glory: the rock of my strength, and my refuge, is in God. Psalm 62:7

Even as I have seen, they that plow iniquity, and sow wickedness, reap the same. By the blast
of God they perish, and by the Breath of His nostrils are they consumed. Job 4:8-9

Let God arise, let His enemies be scattered: let them also that hate Him flee before Him. Psalm 68:1

Thus saith the Lord, learn not the way of the heathen, and be not dismayed at the signs of heaven; for the heathen are dismayed at them. Jeremiah 10:2

Cast thy burden upon the Lord, and He shall sustain thee: He shall never suffer the righteous to be moved. Psalm 55:22 (*sustain: strengthen, support, preserve, keep alive, validate, vindicate, authenticate, justify*)

Keep me as the apple of the Eye, hide me under the shadow of Thy wings, from the wicked that oppress me, from my deadly enemies, who compass me about. Psalm 17:8-9

When you go to war against your enemies and see horses and chariots and an army greater than yours, do not be afraid of them, because the Lord your God, who brought you up out of Egypt, will be with you. Deuteronomy 20:1 NIV

And you shall chase your enemies, and they shall fall before you by the sword. And five of you shall chase a hundred, and a hundred of you shall put ten thousand to flight: and your enemies shall fall before you by the sword. Leviticus 26:7-8

For You have armed me with strength for the battle; You have subdued under me those who rose up against me. Psalm 18:39 NKJV

That He would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve Him without fear, In Holiness and Righteousness before Him, all the days of our life. Luke 1:74-75

Hear, O Israel, today you are drawing near for battle against your enemies: let not your heart faint. Do not fear or panic or be in dread of them Deuteronomy 20:3 ESV

Now therefore stand still and see this great thing, which the Lord will do before your eyes. 1 Samuel 12:16 RSV

Be strong and of good courage, do not fear or be in dread of them: for it is the Lord your God who goes with you; He will not fail you or forsake you. Deuteronomy 31:6 RSV

I prayed to the Lord, and he answered me. He freed me from all my fears. Those who look to Him for help will be radiant with joy; no shadow of shame will darken their faces. In my desperation I prayed, and the Lord listened; He saved me from all my troubles. For the angel of the Lord is a guard; he surrounds and defends all who fear him. Psalm 34:4-7 NLT

..... and GOD said

You shall not fear them, for it is the Lord your God who fights for you. Deuteronomy 3:22 ESV

In righteousness shall you be established; You shall be far from oppression, for you shall not fear; and from terror, for it shall not come near you. Isaiah 54:14 NKJV (*oppression: unjust, cruel exercise of authority or power*) • (*a sense of heaviness in body or mind*)

Job 5:21-22

- You shall be hidden from the scourge of the tongue, and you shall not be afraid of destruction when it comes. AMPC
- You shall laugh at destruction and famine, and you shall not be afraid of the beasts of the earth. NKJV
- You will be safe from slander and have no fear when destruction comes. You will laugh at destruction and famine; wild animals will not terrify you. NLT

And the Lord gave them rest on every side, just as He had solemnly promised their ancestors. None of their enemies could stand against them, for the Lord helped them conquer ALL their enemies. Not a single one of ALL the good promises the Lord had given to the family of Israel was left unfulfilled; everything He had spoken came true. Joshua 21:44-45 NLT

The Word of the Lord came unto Abram in a vision, saying, Fear not, Abram: I AM thy shield, and thy exceeding great reward. Genesis 15:1

See, the Lord your God has set the land before you. Go up, take possession, as the Lord, the God of your fathers, has told you. Do not fear or be dismayed. Deuteronomy 1:21 ESV

The Lord has taken away your punishment, He has turned back your enemy. The Lord, the King of Israel, is with you, never again will you fear any harm. Zephaniah 3:15 NIV

But when ye go over Jordan, and dwell in the land which the Lord your God gives you to inherit, and when He gives you rest from ALL your enemies round about, so that ye dwell in safety Deuteronomy 12:10

I will make a covenant of peace with my people and drive away the dangerous animals from the land. Then they will be able to camp safely in the wildest places and sleep in the woods without fear. Ezekiel 34:25 NLT

According to the Word that I covenanted with you when ye came out of Egypt, so My Spirit remains among you: fear ye not. Haggai 2:5

To give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace. Luke 1:79

Then you will prosper if you are careful to observe the statutes and the ordinances which the Lord commanded Moses for Israel. Be strong, and of good courage. Fear not; be not dismayed.

1 Chronicles 22:13 RSV

Psalms 18:16-19

- He sent from above, He took me; He drew me out of many waters. He delivered me from my strong enemy, from those who hated me, for they were too strong for me. They confronted me in the day of my calamity, but the Lord was my support. He also brought me out into a broad place; He delivered me because He delighted in me. NKJV
- The Lord reached down from above and took me; He pulled me from the deep water. from those who hated me, because they were too strong for me. They attacked me at my time of trouble, but the Lord supported me. He took me to a safe place. Because He delights in me, He saved me. NCV

Fear not, for I AM with you and will favor you with blessings and multiply your descendants.

Genesis 26:24 AMPC

Now therefore fear ye not: I will nourish you, and your little ones. And He comforted them, and spoke kindly unto them. Genesis 50:21

But I am poor and needy: make haste unto me, O God: Thou art my help and my deliverer; O Lord, make no tarrying. Psalm 70:5

For Thou art great, and doest wondrous things: Thou art God alone. Teach me Thy way, O Lord; I will walk in Thy truth: unite my heart to fear Thy Name. I will praise thee, O Lord my God, with all my heart: and I will glorify Thy Name for evermore. For great is Thy mercy toward me: and Thou hast delivered my soul from the lowest hell. God, the proud are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent men have sought after my soul; and have not set Thee before them. Psalm 86:10-14

The Lord executes righteousness and judgment for ALL that are oppressed. Psalm 103:6
(*oppressed: to keep in haedship by unjust authority*)

The Lord also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble. Psalm 9:9
(*refuge: sheltered from danger, trouble or pursuit*)

Lord, you have heard the desire of the humble: You will prepare their heart; You will cause Your ear to hear, to do justice to the fatherless and the oppressed, that the man of the earth may oppress no more. Psalm 10:17-18 NKJV

He shall judge the poor of the people, He shall save the children of the needy, and shall break in pieces the oppressor. Psalm 72:4

To the faithful You show yourself faithful, to the blameless You show yourself blameless, to the pure You show yourself pure, but to the devious You show yourself shrewd. You save the humble, but Your eyes are on the haughty to bring them low. 2 Samuel 22:26-28 NIV

Behold, I send an Angel before you to keep you in the way and to bring you into the place which I have prepared. Beware of Him and obey His voice; do not provoke Him, for He will not pardon your transgressions; for My name is in Him. But if you indeed obey His voice and do all that I speak, then I will be an enemy to your enemies and an adversary to your adversaries You shall not bow down to their gods, nor serve them, nor do according to their works; but you shall utterly overthrow them and completely break down their sacred pillars. Exodus 23:20-24 NKJV

Is not your fear of God your confidence, and the integrity of your ways your hope? Job 4:6 RSV
(*fear of God is: reverence, respect, awe*) • (*confidence: conviction, courage, boldness*) • (*integrity: principles, moral, virtue, good character, honesty, sincerity, trustworthiness*)

.... free of fault, you will lift up your face; you will stand firm and without fear. Job 11:15 RSV

Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. John 14:27 NKJV

There is no fear in Love; but perfect Love casts out fear: because fear hath torment. He that fears is not made perfect in Love. 1 John 4:18

These things I have spoken unto you, that in Me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world. John 16:33

Jesus spoke unto them, saying, be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid. Matthew 14:27

Behold, there was a great earthquake, for an Angel of the Lord descended from heaven and came and rolled back the stone and sat on it. His appearance was like lightning, and his clothing white as snow. And for fear of him the guards trembled and became like dead men. But the Angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. He is not here, for He has Risen, as He said. Come, see the place where He lay. Then go quickly and tell his disciples that He has risen from the dead, and behold, He is going before you to Galilee; there you will see Him. See, I have told you." So they departed quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy, and ran to tell His disciples. And behold, Jesus met them and said, "Greetings!" And they came up and took hold of His feet and worshiped Him. Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid; go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee, and there they will see Me." Matthew 28:2-10 ESV

And Jesus came and touched them, and said, arise, and be not afraid. Matthew 17:7

But overhearing what they said, Jesus said to the ruler of the synagogue, "Do not fear, only believe." Mark 5:36 ESV

As for God, His way is Perfect: the Word of the Lord is tried: He is a buckler to all those that trust in Him. Psalm 18:30 (*perfect: flawless, absolute, unequaled*) • (*tried: proven, reliable*) • (*buckler: shield and protector*)

Luke 10:18-20

- And He said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over ALL the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven. KJV
- And He said to them, I saw Satan falling like a lightning [flash] from heaven. Behold! I have given you authority and power to trample upon serpents and scorpions, and [physical and mental strength and ability] over ALL the power that the enemy [possesses]; and nothing shall in any way harm you. Nevertheless, do not rejoice at this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are enrolled in heaven. AMPC
- Jesus said, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Listen, I have given you power to walk on snakes and scorpions, power that is greater than the enemy has. So nothing will hurt you. But you should not be happy because the spirits obey you but because your names are written in heaven." NCV
- "Yes," he told them, "I saw Satan fall from heaven like lightning! Look, I have given you authority over ALL the power of the enemy, and you can walk among snakes and scorpions and crush them. Nothing will injure you. But don't rejoice because evil spirits obey you; rejoice because your names are registered in heaven." NLT

You shall not oppress and wrong one another, but you shall [reverently] fear your God.
For I AM the Lord your God. Leviticus 25:17 AMPC

If you see the oppression of the poor and the violent taking away of justice and righteousness in the state or province, do not marvel at the matter. [Be sure that there are those who will attend to it] for a higher [official] than the high is observing, and higher ones are over them. Ecclesiastes 5:8 AMPC

For He shall deliver the needy when he cried; the poor also, and him that hath no helper. He shall spare the poor and needy and shall save the souls of the needy. He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence: and precious shall their blood be in His sight. Psalm 72:12-14

You shall not curse the deaf or put a stumbling block before the blind, but you shall [reverently] fear your God. I AM the Lord. You shall do no injustice in judging a case; you shall not be partial to the poor or show a preference for the mighty, but in righteousness and according to the merits of the case judge your neighbor. You shall not go up and down as a dispenser of gossip and scandal among your people, nor shall you [secure yourself by false testimony or by silence and] endanger the life of your neighbor. I AM the Lord. Leviticus 19:15-16 AMPC

A perverse man sows strife, and a whisperer separates close friends. The exceedingly grasping, covetous, and violent man entices his neighbor, leading him in a way that is not good.
Proverbs 16:28-29 AMPC

Your hand will find all Your enemies; Your right hand will find those who hate You. Psalm 21:8 NKJV

And the Angel of the Lord said ... be not afraid of him ... 2 Kings 1:15

And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance forever. Isaiah 32:17

This is the Word of the Lord Not by might, nor by power, but by My Spirit, saith the Lord of Hosts. Zechariah 4:6 KJV

For I AM the Lord, I change not Malachi 3:6

Thou art my King, O God: command deliverances for Jacob. Through Thee will we push down our enemies: through Thy Name will we tread them under that rise up against us. For I will not trust in my bow, neither shall my sword save me. But Thou hast saved us from our enemies, and hast put them to shame that hated us. In God we boast all the day long, and praise Thy Name forever. *Selah* Psalm 44:4-8

From the end of the earth will I cry unto Thee, when my heart is overwhelmed: lead me to the Rock that is higher than I. Psalm 61:2

See, the Lord, the Lord Almighty, will lop off the boughs with great power. The lofty trees will be felled, the tall ones will be brought low. Isaiah 10:33 (*lop: cut off, prune, remove*) • (*bough: arm*) • (*stature: influence, position, prominence, fame, celebrity*)

The day is Yours, and Yours also the night; You established the sun and moon. It was You who set ALL the boundaries of the earth; You made both summer and winter. Remember how the enemy has mocked You, Lord, how foolish people have reviled Your name. Do not hand over the life of Your dove to wild beasts; do not forget the lives of Your afflicted people forever. Have regard for Your Covenant, because haunts of violence fill the dark places of the land. Do not let the oppressed retreat in disgrace; may the poor and needy praise Your Name. Rise up, O God, and defend Your cause; remember how fools mock You all day long. Do not ignore the clamor of Your adversaries, the uproar of Your enemies, which rises continually. Psalm 74:16-23 NIV

..... and GOD said

Fear not; stand still (firm, confident, undismayed) and see the salvation of the Lord which He will work for you today. Exodus 14:13 AMPC

He hath delivered my soul in peace from the battle that was against me: for there were many with me. Psalm 55:18

God is our protection and our strength. He always helps in times of trouble. So we will not be afraid even if the earth shakes, or the mountains fall into the sea, even if the oceans roar and foam, or the mountains shake at the raging sea. *Selah*. Psalm 46:1-3 NCV

Before the mountains were born and before You created the earth and the world, You are God. You have always been, and You will always be. Psalm 90:2 NCV

I lead in the way of righteousness, in the midst of the paths of judgment: That I may cause those that love Me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures. The Lord possessed me in the beginning of His way, before His works of old. I was set up from everlasting, from the beginning, or ever the earth was. When there were no depths, I was brought forth; when there were no fountains abounding with water. Before the mountains were settled, before the hills was I brought forth Proverbs 8:20-25

Teach me Your way, O Lord, and lead me in a plain and even path because of my enemies [those who lie in wait for me]. Give me not up to the will of my adversaries, for false witnesses have risen up against me; they breathe out cruelty and violence. [What, what would have become of me] had I not believed that I would see the Lord's Goodness in the land of the living! Wait and hope for and expect the Lord; be brave and of good courage and let your heart be stout and enduring. Yes, wait for and hope for and expect the Lord. Psalm 27:11-14 AMPC

Psalm 59:1-10 ESV

1. Deliver me from my enemies, O my God; protect me from those who rise up against me;
2. deliver me from those who work evil and save me from bloodthirsty men.
3. For behold, they lie in wait for my life; fierce men stir up strife against me. For no transgression or sin of mine, O Lord,
4. for no fault of mine, they run and make ready. Awake, come to meet me, and see!
5. You, Lord God of Hosts, are God of Israel. Rouse yourself to punish ALL the nations; spare none of those who treacherously plot evil. *Selah*
6. Each evening they come back, howling like dogs and prowling about the city.
7. There they are, bellowing with their mouths with swords in their lips—for “Who,” they think, “will hear us?”
8. But You, O Lord, laugh at them; You hold ALL the nations in derision.
9. O my Strength, I will watch for You, for You, O God, are my Fortress.
10. My God in His steadfast Love will meet me; God will let me look in triumph on my enemies.

Only do not rebel against the Lord. And do not fear the people of the land, for they are bread for us. Their protection is removed from them, and the Lord is with us; do not fear them. Numbers 14:9 ESV

People are saying that others make plans against them, but you should not believe them. Don't be afraid of what they fear; do not dread those things. Isaiah 8:12 NCV

Don't be afraid. God has come to test you and instill a deep and reverent awe within you so that you won't sin. Exodus 20:20 MSG

Watch out for people who try to dazzle you with big words and intellectual double-talk. They want to drag you off into endless arguments that never amount to anything. They spread their ideas through the empty traditions of human beings and the empty superstitions of spirit beings. But that's not the way of Christ. Everything of God gets expressed in Him, so you can see and hear Him clearly. You don't need a telescope, a microscope, or a horoscope to realize the fullness of Christ, and the emptiness of the universe without him. When you come to Him, that fullness comes together for you, too. His power extends over everything. Colossians 2:10 MSG

Psalm 140 NLT

1. O Lord, rescue me from evil people. Protect me from those who are violent,
2. those who plot evil in their hearts and stir up trouble all day long.
3. Their tongues sting like a snake; the venom of a viper drips from their lips.
4. O Lord, keep me out of the hands of the wicked. Protect me from those who are violent, for they are plotting against me.
5. The proud have set a trap to catch me; they have stretched out a net; they have placed traps all along the way.
6. I said to the Lord, "You are my God!" Listen, O Lord, to my cries for mercy!
7. O Sovereign Lord, the strong one who rescued me, you protected me on the day of battle.
8. Lord, do not let evil people have their way. Do not let their evil schemes succeed, or they will become proud.
9. Let my enemies be destroyed by the very evil they have planned for me.
10. Let burning coals fall down on their heads. Let them be thrown into the fire or into watery pits from which they can't escape.
11. Don't let liars prosper here in our land. Cause great disasters to fall on the violent.
12. But I know the Lord will help those they persecute; He will give justice to the poor.
13. Surely righteous people are praising Your Name; the godly will live in Your Presence.

What sorrow for those who drag their sins behind them with ropes made of lies, who drag wickedness behind them like a cart! They even mock God and say, "Hurry up and do something! We want to see what you can do. Let the Holy One of Israel carry out His plan, for we want to know what it is."

What sorrow for those who say that evil is good and good is evil, that dark is light, and light is dark, that bitter is sweet and sweet is bitter. What sorrow for those who are wise in their own eyes and think themselves so clever. What sorrow for those who are heroes at drinking wine and boast about all the alcohol they can hold. They take bribes to let the wicked go free, and they punish the innocent.

Therefore, just as fire licks up stubble and dry grass shrivels in the flame, so their roots will rot and their flowers wither. For they have rejected the Law of the Lord of Heaven's Armies; they have despised the Word of the Holy One of Israel. Isaiah 5:18-24 NLT

Psalm 15 NIV

1. Lord, who may dwell in your sacred tent? Who may live on your holy mountain?
 2. The one whose walk is blameless, who does what is righteous, who speaks the truth from their heart;
 3. whose tongue utters no slander, who does no wrong to a neighbor, and casts no slur on others;
 4. who despises a vile person but honors those who Fear the Lord; who keeps an oath even when it hurts, and does not change their mind;
 5. who lends money to the poor without interest; who does not accept a bribe against the innocent.
- Whoever does these things will never be shaken.

The Almighty—we cannot find Him; He is great in power and justice, and abundant righteousness. He will not violate. Therefore men fear Him; He does not regard any who are wise in their own conceit. Job 37:23-24 RSV

Psalm 7 AMPC

1. O Lord my God, in You I take refuge and put my trust; save me from all those who pursue and persecute me, and deliver me,
2. Lest my foe tear my life [from my body] like a lion, dragging me away while there is none to deliver.
3. O Lord my God, if I have done this, if there is wrong in my hands,
4. If I have paid back with evil him who was at peace with me or without cause have robbed him who was my enemy,
5. Let the enemy pursue my life and take it; yes, let him trample my life to the ground and lay my honor in the dust. Selah [pause, and calmly think of that]!
6. Arise, O Lord, in Your anger; lift up Yourself against the rage of my enemies; and awake [and stir up] for me the justice and vindication [that] You have commanded.
7. Let the assembly of the peoples be gathered about You, and return on high over them.
8. The Lord judges the people; judge me, O Lord, and do me justice according to my righteousness [my rightness, justice, and right standing with You] and according to the integrity that is in me.
9. Oh, let the wickedness of the wicked come to an end, but establish the [uncompromisingly] righteous [those upright and in harmony with You]; for You, Who try the hearts and emotions and thinking powers, are a Righteous God.
10. My defense and shield depend on God, Who saves the upright in heart.
11. God is a Righteous Judge, yes, a God Who is indignant every day.
12. If a man does not turn and repent, [God] will whet His sword; He has strung and bent His [huge] bow and made it ready [by treading it with His foot].
13. He has also prepared for him deadly weapons; He makes His arrows fiery shafts.
14. Behold, [the wicked man] conceives iniquity and is pregnant with mischief and gives birth to lies.
15. He made a pit and hollowed it out and has fallen into the hole which he made [before the trap was completed].
16. His mischief shall fall back in return upon his own head, and his violence come down [with the loose dirt] upon his own scalp.
17. I will give to the Lord the thanks due to His rightness and justice, and I will sing praise to the name of the Lord Most High.

God is a safe place to hide, ready to help when we need him. We stand fearless at the cliff-edge of doom, courageous in sea storm and earthquake, before the rush and roar of oceans, the tremors that shift mountains. Jacob-wrestling God fights for us, God-of-Angel-Armies protects us. Psalm 46:2 MSG

A message from the high and towering God, who lives in Eternity, whose name is Holy: "I live in the high and holy places, but also with the low-spirited, the spirit-crushed, and what I do is put a New Spirit in them, get them up and on their feet again Peace to the far-off, peace to the near-at-hand," says God—"and yes, I will heal them. But the wicked are storm-battered seas that can't quiet down. The waves stir up garbage and mud. There's no peace," God says, "for the wicked." Isaiah 57:15-21 MSG

I want you also to be smart, making sure every "good" thing is the real thing. Don't be gullible in regard to smooth-talking evil. Stay alert like this, and before you know it the God of Peace will come down on Satan with both feet, stomping him into the dirt. Enjoy the best of Jesus! Romans 16:20 MSG

Psalm 27:1-6 NLT

1. The Lord is my light and my salvation—so why should I be afraid? The Lord is my fortress, protecting me from danger, so why should I tremble?
2. When evil people come to devour me, when my enemies and foes attack me, they will stumble and fall.
3. Though a mighty army surrounds me, my heart will not be afraid. Even if I am attacked, I will remain confident.
4. The one thing I ask of the Lord—the thing I seek most—is to live in the House of the Lord all the days of my life, delighting in the Lord's perfections and meditating in His Temple.
5. For He will conceal me there when troubles come; He will hide me in His sanctuary. He will place me out of reach on a high rock.
