The wisdom of the prudent is to understand his way: but the folly of fools is deceit. Fools make a mock at sin: but among the righteous there is favor. Proverbs 14:8-9

Proverbs 13:15

- Good understanding gives favor: but the way of transgressors is hard. KJV
- Sound thinking makes for gracious living, but liars walk a rough road. MSG
- Good sense wins favor, but the way of the treacherous is their ruin. ESV
- Good judgment wins favor, but the way of the unfaithful leads to their destruction. NIV
- A person with good sense is respected; a treacherous person is headed for destruction.
 NLT
- People with good understanding will be well liked, but the lives of those who are not trustworthy are hard. NCV

For you are a holy and set-apart people to the Lord your God; the Lord your God has chosen you to be a special people to Himself out of all the peoples on the face of the earth.

A good man obtains favor of the Lord: but a man of wicked devices will He condemn. Proverbs 12:2

Psalm 30:7

- By Your favor, O Lord, You have established me as a strong mountain; You hid Your face, and I was troubled. AMPC
- Lord, in your kindness You made my mountain safe. But when You turned away, I was frightened. NCV
- Lord, when You favored me, You made my royal mountain stand firm; but when You hid your face, I was dismayed. NIV
- Your favor, O Lord, made me as secure as a mountain. Then You turned away from me, and I was shattered. NLT

Proverbs 11:27-28

- He that diligently seeks good procures favor: but he that seeks mischief, it shall come unto him. He that trusts in his riches shall fall; but the righteous shall flourish as a branch. KJV
- If you search for good, you will find favor; but if you search for evil, it will find you! Trust in your money and down you go! But the godly flourish like leaves in spring. NLT

Psalm 112:5

- A good man deals graciously and lends; he will guide his affairs with discretion. NKJV
- It is well with the man who deals generously and lends, who conducts his affairs with justice. AMPC
- Good comes to those who lend money generously and conduct their business fairly. NLT
- It is good to be merciful and generous. Those who are fair in their business will never be defeated. Good people will always be remembered. NCV

For His anger lasts only a moment, but His favor lasts a lifetime; weeping may stay for the night, but rejoicing comes in the morning. Psalm 30:5 NIV

And he said, "O Lord, if it is true that I have found favor with you, then please travel with us. Yes, this is a stubborn and rebellious people, but please forgive our iniquity and our sins. Claim us as Your own special possession." Exodus 34:9 NLT

The fear of man brings a snare, but whoever trusts in the Lord shall be safe. Many seek the ruler's favor, but justice for man comes from the Lord. An unjust man is an abomination to the righteous, and he who is upright in the way is an abomination to the wicked.

Proverbs 29:25-27 NKJV

But I lavish unfailing love for a thousand generations on those who love Me and obey My commands. Exodus 20:6 NLT

Know therefore that the Lord thy God, He is God, the faithful God, which keeps covenant and mercy with them that love Him and keep His commandments to a thousand generations Deuteronomy 7:9

And he said, Lord God of Israel, there is no God like thee, in heaven above, or on earth beneath, who keeps covenant and mercy with Thy servants that walk before thee with all their heart 1 Kings 8:23

GRACE

But my life is worth nothing to me unless I use it for finishing the work assigned me by the Lord Jesus—the work of telling others the Good News about the wonderful Grace of God. Acts 20:24 NLT

For the Lord God is a sun and shield: the Lord will give grace and glory: no good thing will He withhold from them that walk uprightly. Psalm 64:11

God said to Moses: "All right. Just as you say; this also I will do, for I know you well and you are special to me. I know you by name." Exodus 33:17 MSG

Do not devise evil against your neighbor, for he dwells by you for safety's sake. Do not strive with a man without cause, if he has done you no harm. Do not envy the oppressor and choose none of his ways; for the perverse person is an abomination to the Lord, but His secret counsel is with the upright. The curse of the Lord is on the house of the wicked, but He blesses the home of the just. Surely, He scorns the scornful, but gives Grace to the humble. The wise shall inherit glory, but shame shall be the legacy of fools. Proverbs 3:29-35 NKJV

Proverbs 22:11

- God loves the pure-hearted and well-spoken; good leaders also delight in their friendship.
 MSG
- He who loves purity the pure in heart who is gracious in speech—because of the grace
 of His lips will he have the king for his friend. AMPC

And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His Glory, the Glory as of the only begotten of the Father), full of grace and truth. John 1:14

For out of His fullness (abundance) we have all received [all had a share and we were all supplied with] one grace after another and spiritual blessing upon spiritual blessing and even favor upon favor and gift [heaped] upon gift. For while the Law was given through Moses, grace (unearned, undeserved favor and spiritual blessing) and truth came through Jesus Christ. John 1:16-17 AMPC

The whole congregation of believers was united as one—one heart, one mind! They didn't even claim ownership of their own possessions. No one said, "That's mine; you can't have it." They shared everything. The apostles gave powerful witness to the resurrection of the Master Jesus, and Grace was on all of them. Acts 4:33 MSG

Now I'm turning you over to God, our marvelous God whose gracious Word can make you into what He wants you to be and give you everything you could possibly need in this community of holy friends. Acts 20:32 MSG

We believe that we are all saved the same way, by the undeserved Grace of the Lord Jesus. Acts 15:11 NLT

For all have sinned and fall short of the Glory of God, and all are justified freely by His Grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. Romans 3:23-24 NIV

All that passing laws against sin did was produce more lawbreakers. But sin didn't, and doesn't, have a chance in competition with the aggressive forgiveness we call Grace. When it's sin versus Grace, Grace wins hands down. All sin can do is threaten us with death, and that's the end of it. Grace, because God is putting everything together again through the Messiah, invites us into life—a life that goes on and on and on, world without end. Romans 5:20 MSG

AGING

Now also when I am old and grey headed, O God, forsake me not; until I have shown Thy strength unto this generation, and Thy power to everyone that is to come. Psalm 71:18

I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread. Psalm 37:25

I've been carrying you on my back from the day you were born, and I'll keep on carrying you when you're old. I'll be there, bearing you when you're old and gray. I've done it and will keep on doing it, carrying you on My back, saving you. Isaiah 46:4 MSG

Cast me not off in the time of old age; forsake me not when my strength fails. Psalm 71:9

Praise be to God, who has not rejected my prayer or withheld His love from me! Psalm 66:20 NIV

They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be fat and flourishing. Psalm 92:14 (fat: having the best of everything, rich, prosperous, wealthy, abundant, profitable)

Likewise the Spirit also helps our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. Romans 8:26

Is not wisdom found among the aged? Does not long life bring understanding? To God belong Wisdom and Power; Counsel and Understanding are His. Job 12:12-13 NIV

He will swallow up death in victory; and the Lord God will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of His people shall He take away from off all the earth: for the Lord hath spoken it. Isaiah 25:8

Great men are not always wise: neither do the aged understand judgment. Psalm 32:9

The glory of young men is their strength: and the beauty of old men is the grey head. Proverbs 20:29

Your job is to speak out on the things that make for solid doctrine. Guide older men into lives of temperance, dignity, and wisdom, into healthy faith, love, and endurance. Guide older women into lives of reverence so they end up as neither gossips nor drunks, but models of goodness. By looking at them, the younger women will know how to love their husbands and children, be virtuous and pure, keep a good house, be good wives. We don't want anyone looking down on God's Message because of their behavior. Titus 2:1-5 MSG

And now, behold, the Lord hath kept me alive, as He said, these forty and five years, even since the Lord spoke this word unto Moses, while the children of Israel wandered in the wilderness: and now, Io, I am this day fourscore and five (85) years old (Caleb). As yet I am as strong this day as I was in the day that Moses sent me: as my strength was then, even so is my strength now, for war, both to go out, and to come in. Now therefore give me this mountain if so, be the Lord will be with me, then I shall be able to drive them out, as the Lord said. Joshua 14:10-12

Hear, O my son, and receive my sayings; and the years of thy life shall be many. I have taught thee in the way of Wisdom; I have led thee in right paths. When thou goest, thy steps shall not be straitened; and when thou runnest, thou shalt not stumble. Take fast hold of instruction; let her not go: keep her; for she is thy life. Enter not into the path of the wicked, and go not in the way of evil men. Avoid it, pass not by it, turn from it, and pass away. For they sleep not, except they have done mischief; and their sleep is taken away, unless they cause some to fall. For they eat the bread of wickedness and drink the wine of violence. But the path of the just is as the shining light, that shines more and more unto the perfect day. Proverbs 4:10-18

Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on in-corruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruptible, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory. Death, where is thy sting?

O grave, where is thy victory? The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, which gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, inasmuch as ye know that your labor is not in vain in the Lord. 1 Corinthians 15:51-58

This poor man cried out, and the Lord heard him, and saved him out of all his troubles. The Angel of the Lord encamps all around those who fear Him, and delivers them. Psalm 34:6-7 NKJV

Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is cast into the oven, shall He not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith? Matthew 6:30

You will lie down unafraid, and many will look to you for help. Job 11:19 NLT

How much more surely shall the Blood of Christ, who by virtue of [His] eternal Spirit [His own preexistent divine personality] has offered Himself as an unblemished sacrifice to God, purify our consciences from dead works and lifeless observances to serve the [ever] living God? Hebrews 9:14 AMPC

And though your beginning was small, yet your latter end would greatly increase. For inquire, I pray you, of the former age and apply yourself to that which their fathers have searched out, for we are but of yesterday and know nothing, because our days upon earth are a shadow. Shall not [the forefathers] teach you and tell you and utter words out of their hearts (the deepest part of their nature)? Job 8:7-10 AMPC

I shall put My Spirit in you, and ye shall live, and I shall place you in your own land: then shall ye know that I the Lord have spoken it, and performed it, saith the Lord. Ezekiel 37:14 But how can people call for help if they don't know who to trust? And how can they know who to trust if they haven't heard of the One who can be trusted? And how can they hear if nobody tells them? And how is anyone going to tell them unless someone is sent to do it? That's why Scripture exclaims, a sight to take your breath away! Grand processions of people telling all the good things of God! But not everybody is ready for this, ready to see and hear and act. Isaiah asked what we all ask at one time or another: "Does anyone care, God? Is anyone listening and believing a word of it?" The point is: before you trust, you have to listen. But unless Christ's Word is preached, there's nothing to listen to. Romans 10:17 MSG

Give ear, O ye heavens, and I will speak; and hear, O earth, the Words of My mouth. Deuteronomy 32:1

The hearing ear, and the seeing eye, the Lord hath made even both of them. Proverbs 20:12

He that turns away his ear from hearing the law, even his prayer shall be abomination. Proverbs 28:9

But the Word is very nigh unto thee, in thy mouth, and in thy heart, that thou mayest do it. Deuteronomy 30:14

And thine ears shall hear a Word behind thee, saying, this is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left. Isaiah 30:21

"Surely blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply you." Hebrews 6:14 NKJV And I will make thy seed to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give unto thy seed all these countries; and in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed. Genesis 26:4

WEARY-NESS

And let us not lose heart and grow weary and faint in acting nobly and doing right, for in due time and at the appointed season we shall reap, if we do not loosen and relax our courage and faint. Galatians 6:9 AMPC
